**Note: All individuals using the facility must adhere to these guidelines in addition to Federal and Provincial Health Orders.**

**Mandatory Masks/Face Coverings** – Public Skaters must wear masks/face coverings at all times inside the Eddie Mountain Arena. Masks may only be removed once you enter onto the ice surface. Skaters will not be permitted entry into the facility without a mask. No Exceptions. There will be no spectators allowed at this point. If your child/children are unable to wear a mask, you must both come to the facility in full equipment (skates w/ skate guards, helmet, etc.) & immediately go onto the ice. Dressing Use usage must only be used by users wearing masks.

#### Entering and Exiting the Facility

##### 1. ENTRANCE

- a. Skaters will enter the Facility through Door “B” on the South side of the building.
- b. Facility entry will only be granted 15 minutes prior to Public Skating time.
- c. Late arrivals will not be permitted inside the facility – no exceptions.
- d. There will be a maximum of 20 people per Public Skating session. Doors will be locked after the first 20 skaters arrive.
- e. Re-entry will not be allowed for any reason.

##### 2. CONTACT TRACING

- a. Arena Attendant will ask for your name upon arrival to check you are on the season's pass list. If you have not purchased a season's pass, you will not be on the list and cannot enter the facility.

##### 3. EXIT

- a. Once Public Skating has ended, users will have 15 minutes to exit the facility through the Door “B”.

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Skating and Dressing Rooms

1. DRESSING ROOMS
  - a. Dressing Rooms 1 & 2 will only be permitted for Public Skating.
  - b. Both dressing rooms have a maximum amount of 10 people per dressing room.
2. SKATING
  - a. Skaters must ensure they are socially distancing themselves (2m) from others not in their household while using the ice.
  - b. Skaters may not leave the dressing room area or ice surface at any point. The lobby will not be made available.
