



EVACUATION ALERT (PARTIAL RESCIND)

St Mary's Lake Road Area

August 5, 2026, at 12:00 pm

The Evacuation Alert issued on July 19th, 2026, for 66 properties on St. Mary Lake Rd by the **Regional District of East Kootenay** due to the **Tower Creek Wildfires (N10944, N10947)** has been **reduced** in size.

The Evacuation alert is rescinded for 65 properties on St Mary Lake Rd. Only the following property remains in Evacuation Alert:

- **4404 ST MARY LAKE RD**

An **Evacuation Alert** is issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises, or property should be found necessary.

Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

If it is deemed necessary to expand an Evacuation Alert, the Evacuation Alert process will recommence.

EVACUATION ALERT - Information

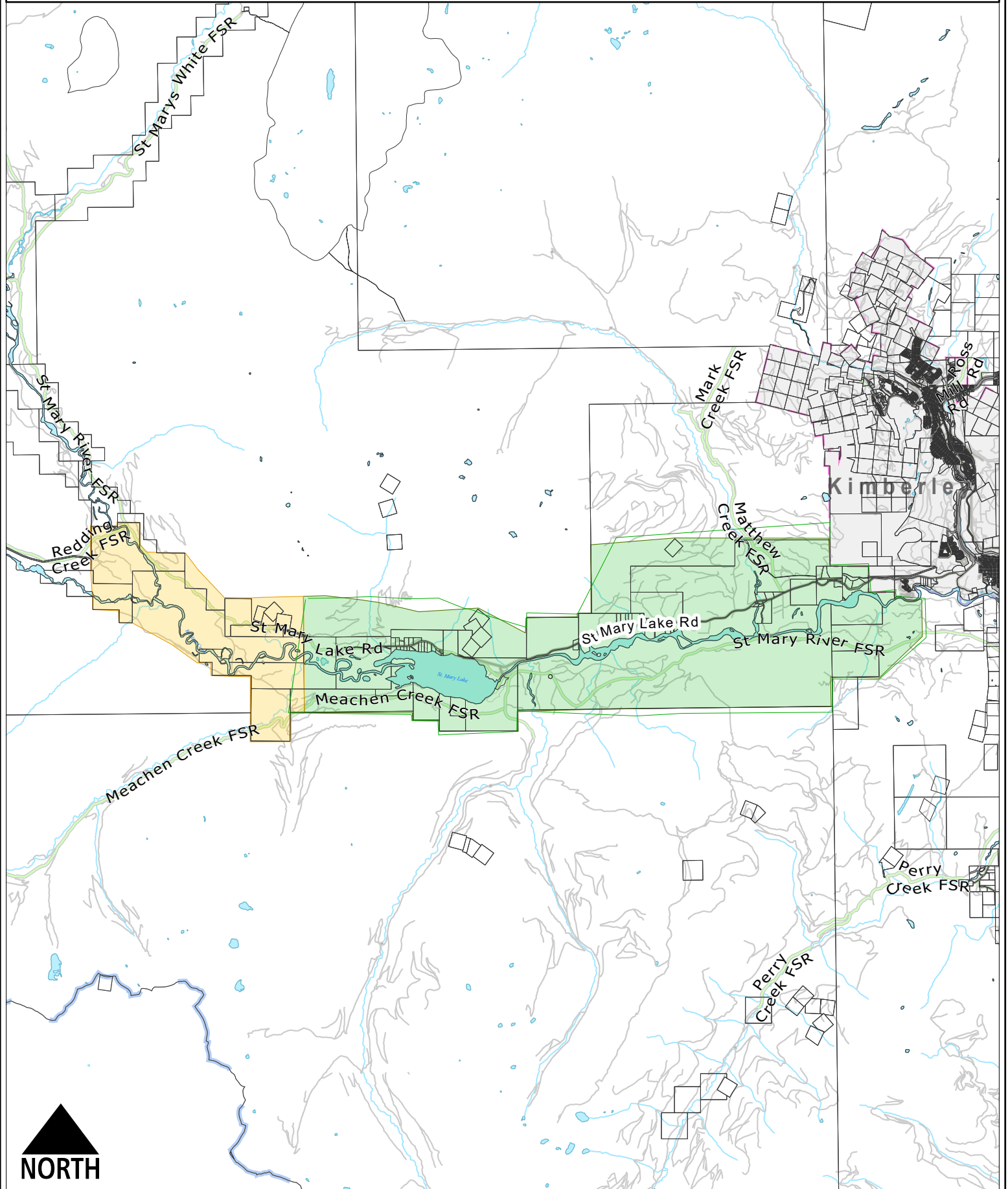
WHAT YOU SHOULD DO during the Evacuation Alert Stage:

- Register for the Evacuation Notification System at www.rdek.bc.ca – this will ensure that we can reach you rapidly if the evacuation status changes.
- Arrange a meeting location outside of the Evacuation Alert area where family members can meet if an Evacuation Order is issued while not together.
- Have a ‘To-Go Bag’ packed and ready to leave at a moment’s notice, with essential items such as:
 - Government-issued ID
 - Medications, eyeglasses, and transportable medical equipment
 - Money
 - Clothing, personal care items and immediate needs for your dependents
 - Important documents (e.g. insurance, banking and mortgage info)
 - Valuables and keepsakes
- **Pets and animals:** Please relocate any large animals to a safe area and prepare to take your pets with you, include:
 - Food and water
 - Carriers or travel trailers
 - Medication
 - Anything necessary for the animal’s safe and well-being

- Relocate recreational vehicles and boats at the Alert stage as there will not be time to move them in the event of an Order.
- Ensure there is enough fuel in vehicles to safely leave the area if an Evacuation Order is issued.
- Plan ahead for accommodation should an Order need to be issued, if possible, stay with friends or relatives, or find alternative accommodations.
- Should an Evacuation Order need to be issued, provincial Emergency Support Services are only available for those displaced from their **primary residence**.
- Pre-register all household members on the provincial Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) Tool at ess.gov.bc.ca. People who have a BC Services Card may be eligible to receive an e-transfer using the BC Services Card App.
- Please secure your firearms in accordance with Section 118 of the *Firearms Act*.
- Monitor credible **news sources** and www.rdek.bc.ca for information.
