

## **EVACUATION ORDER**

### FENWICK ROAD AREA NEAR KOOTENAY RIVER

November 29, 2025, AT 12:30PM

Whereas a state of local emergency was declared on **November 29, 2025** by the **Regional District of East Kootenay** pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to **Train Derailment.** 

And whereas **Train Derailment** poses an immediate danger to life safety in **Electoral Area C**; this **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the **Regional District of East Kootenay** pursuant to Section 107 (1)(c) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*.

The Evacuation Order is in effect as of 12:30PM for the following properties (See Attached Map):

- 2625 Fenwick Road
- 2627 Fenwick Road
- 3607 Fenwick Road
- 3611 Fenwick Road
- 3664 Fenwick Road

### YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

Emergency Support Services (ESS) is available if needed. If you require ESS support, contact the RDEK Duty Phone at **250-489-6977**. ESS is only available to those displaced from their <u>primary</u> residence.

# **EVACUATION ORDER - Information**

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Leave the Evacuation Order area immediately.
- Follow the directions of emergency responders and/or traffic control personnel.
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use any additional vehicles than necessary.
- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice or call 250-489-9677.
- Take critical items (IDs, medication, money, clothing, care items, important documents, and valuables) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in carriers or on leash.
- Do **NOT** turn off your natural gas. FortisBC will shut off the service if deemed necessary.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Register your household on the provincial Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) Tool at <u>ess.gov.bc.ca</u> and proceed to the closest ESS Reception Centre. If you are unable to register online, please contact 250-426-2188.
- Monitor credible news sources and www.rdek.bc.ca for information.
