Is the construction and demolition waste from a new build or a renovation project being completed on a building built after 1990?

SOIL CAN BE ACCEPTED at the Regional District of East Kotoenay's three subregional landfills:

- Columbia Valley Landfill
- Central Subregion Landfill
- Sparwood Landfill

Many building materials have gotten safer as regulations have come into place. Due to this, new construction material can be brought to all three subregional landfills for direct bury. Regular tipping fees apply.
