

CENTRAL SUBREGION TIPPING FEE SCHEDULE

Last Updated: June 2022

This is a reference sheet for Central Subregion Tipping Fees which are chargeable as per the Central Subregion Waste Management Regulatory Bylaw No. 1505, 2000. Every effort will be made to update this reference sheet to reflect the current bylaw.

SOLID WASTE (Commercial & Domestic Refuse) excluding Controlled Waste

Municipal Solid WasteNO CHARGE
Includes items such as furniture and regular household garbage

CONTROLLED WASTE (Including Industrial Refuse)

Animal carcasses - livestock or big game\$25.00 each
**Material only accepted at Central Subregion Landfill*

Asbestos, dry or slurry\$100.00 per tonne
**Material only accepted at Central Subregion Landfill (approval required)*

Biomedical Waste - treated only\$160.00 per load
**Material only accepted at Central Subregion Landfill*

Construction/Demolition Waste – Mixed\$200.00 per tonne
Includes items such as drywall, tile, carpet, treated lumber, general mixed demolition materials (ie. recreational trailers, camper units, boats, mobile homes, houses)

Construction/Demolition WasteNO CHARGE
Originating from the clean-up of waste illegally left on public land (approval required)

Food Processing Waste\$60.00 per tonne

Land Clearing Waste\$40.00 per tonne

Mattresses or Box SpringsNO CHARGE
Recycling option available at the Cranbrook Transfer Station for Mattresses

Septic Sludge\$10.00 per tonne
**Material only accepted at Central Subregion Landfill*

Soil - Contaminated (not classified as special/hazardous waste)\$100.00 per tonne
**Material only accepted at Central Subregion Landfill (approval required)*

Soil - Clean\$40.00 per tonne

Steel Cables - must be on spool or cut to 1.2m lengths\$60.00 per tonne

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

Asphalt - not contaminated\$40.00 per tonne

Asphalt ShinglesNO CHARGE
**Material only accepted at Central Subregion Landfill*

Auto BatteriesNO CHARGE

Chipped Green Wood WasteNO CHARGE

Clean Wood WasteNO CHARGE

Concrete - not contaminated\$40.00 per tonne

Propane Cylinders - under 100 lbsNO CHARGE

Scrap MetalNO CHARGE
Includes large appliances, white goods, BBQs, etc

Tires:

i) 17" or smaller\$8.00 per tire

ii) 17" or smaller with rim\$14.00 per tire

iii) 18" - 25"\$50.00 per tire

iv) 18" - 25" with rim\$56.00 per tire

v) larger than 25"NOT ACCEPTED

Yard or Garden Waste - under 6" diameterNO CHARGE
If over 6" in diameter, item will be charged as Land Clearing Waste

Auto Hulk - including pickup trucks & vansNOT ACCEPTED

Truck or Bus HulkNOT ACCEPTED

Mobile Home HulkNOT ACCEPTED

CHARGES APPLICABLE TO ALL CATEGORIES

Loads containing banned recyclable materials minimum \$100.00 or DOUBLE CHARGE

Uncovered or Unsecured Loads minimum \$ 25.00 or DOUBLE CHARGE
