

Board of Variance Application Procedures

How and where to apply:

Complete a Board of Variance application. These are available from the RDEK offices at:

- 19 24th Avenue South Cranbrook, BC
- 1164 Windermere Loop Road Invermere, BC

The application form is also available online at www.rdek.bc.ca.

Include the following:

- 1. \$350.00 non-refundable fee payable to the Regional District of East Kootenay.
- 2. A detailed sketch of your property showing all buildings, well, septic system, access, and physical features.
- 3. An explanation of your request and any other information, such as photographs in support of your application. This type of application requires you to demonstrate that compliance with the bylaw regulation would cause you undue hardship.
- 4. A Title Search Print dated no more than 30 days before you file your application. These are available from the Land Title Office at www.ltsa.ca. If requested, a Title Search can be obtained by the RDEK for a document fee of \$17.50.
- 5. In some cases, approval from the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure is required. You must obtain this approval before your application can be considered by the Board of Variance.
- 6. In some cases, a completed Site Disclosure Statement is required. See Section 5 of the Application Form for more information.

Take your application, the fee, and the items listed above to the RDEK office in Cranbrook. If it is more convenient, mail your application, fee and required information.

What happens to your application:

Your application will be reviewed:

- RDEK Development Services staff will prepare a report describing the variance and make a recommendation to the Board of Variance.
- A building inspector may visit your property and take photos.
- The RDEK will also refer your application to the provincial government if technical input from one
 of the ministries is needed.

A hearing date will be set:

The RDEK will set a date for your application to be considered by the Board of Variance. You will be notified so you can attend.

Your neighbours will be notified:

RDEK staff will send notices to property owners and tenants within 100 metres of your property to advise them of your application.

The hearing will be held:

The Board of Variance will consider your application. It is very important that you attend the meeting to answer any questions that the Board of Variance may have. The Board of Variance will examine reports from RDEK staff, provincial government (if a report was requested) and review any letters received from your neighbours. The Board of Variance will either approve your application, turn it down, or grant you a partial variance. If your application is approved, the RDEK can issue your building permit.

If your application is turned down:

A decision of the Board of Variance concerning hardship or non-conforming use is final. For further information refer to the *Local Government Act*.
